Updated: July 2022

To assist local education agencies (LEAs) in maintaining compliance with required special education website posting requirements, TEA has developed this checklist to ensure all documents and statements are posted according to the Texas Education Code (TEC) and the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) requirements. This document will be updated periodically to include any new requirements.
